Vice Mayor Bailey announced March 17<sup>th</sup> 5pm workshop on City Redistricting, Main Assembly. 11d., Open meeting resolution for Pension Task Force, postponed 4 weeks, Mayor Brown to submit another resolution (different task force leadership) at next meeting. Several speakers from county employee groups and retired groups in support of 11d. Discussion of dissolving Task Force and providing information and scenarios to commission, thus making commission responsible (and therefore would be open). Mayor Brown intent on keeping a Mayor's Task Force. Councilmembers seemed to support an open process. 12d. Postponed 6 weeks to put together Task Force to research city signs and billboard regulations.
