Were any issues on the agenda relevant to LWV positions or programs? Key discussion surrounding the funding of first year funds of a 5-year Capital Improvement Plan focused on appropriation to the school system. A substitute motion to fund the plan, excepting the approx. \$5m allotted for the renovation of Carter Elementary School, passed 10 to 6 after four hours of intense discussion by several commissioners, Superintendent Jim McIntyre and School Board Chair Indya Kincannon. A large delegation of Carter community residents attended in support of an alternate proposal to build a new elementary school on 28 acres purchased for this purpose several years ago.

Do you recommend League action on any of these issues? Continue monitoring at next month's meeting. All perspectives on this conversation were well-developed and instructive.
